Climate-Related Food Security Project

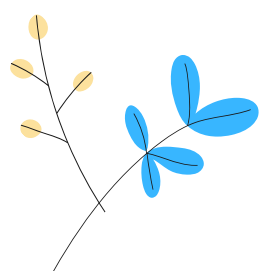

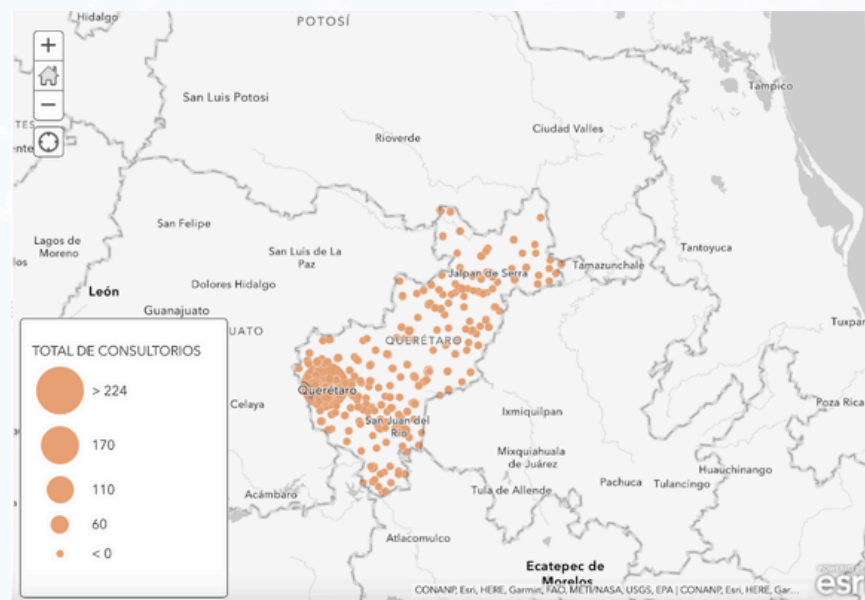
AFYA

Completed a 5-page report exploring the medical supply chain in Sub-Saharan Africa, specifically Ghana, Ethiopia, South Africa, Tanzania and Uganda. The barriers of importing supplies, the general medical supply landscape and recommendations for improvement were examined in detail.



Queretaro Maternal and Neonatal Health Project (MNH)

Contributed to clinical trials for ultrasounds to diagnose congenital heart disease for mothers in low-resource communities in Queretaro and the collection of data through surveys.





Mycetoma Disease Surveillance and Control in Ethiopia





Submitted a research grant report on the training of Health Care Providers (HCP's) and Health Extension Workers (HEW's) to recognize and report Mycetoma cases, along with education on Mycetoma diagnosis and treatment.



Commenced ArcGIS training with a GIS Specialists at NYU Data Services.



Presented our research poster at the APHA conference highlighting the impact of our pilot project in integrating Mycetoma surveillance in the primary healthcare unit of South Ethiopia region.



Middle East and North Africa Project (MENA) x Lebanon Team
